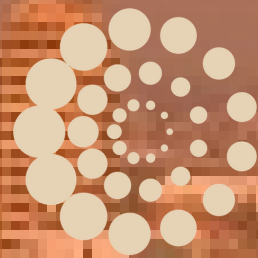


## ASP Città di Bologna

ASP is one of the biggest public company for social welfare in Italy, with more than 550 workers, 80% employed in the services, and a budget of some 89 millions of euros.

### THE REAL ESTATE

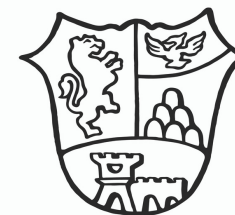
ASP City of Bologna has inherited the real estate belonging to ancient charities of the city and deriving mostly from legacies and donations. Part of the real estate is intended for social activities and part is for profitability.

The "available" property consists of approximately 1,300 properties and 2,000 hectares of land, and to ensure its profitability, it allows ASP City of Bologna to offer quality welfare, service delivery and experimentation of innovative activities to better respond to emerging needs of the city.

### LA QUADRERIA

An heritage of historical-artistic interest - paintings, furnishings, two churches.. is the result of legacies in the 500 years of history of the institutions that formed ASP. In the historical site of Via Marsala 7, it's located La Quadreria, a new museum, open with free entrance, that returns to the city boards and paintings of mainly Bolognese masters from the sixteenth to the eighteenth centuries.

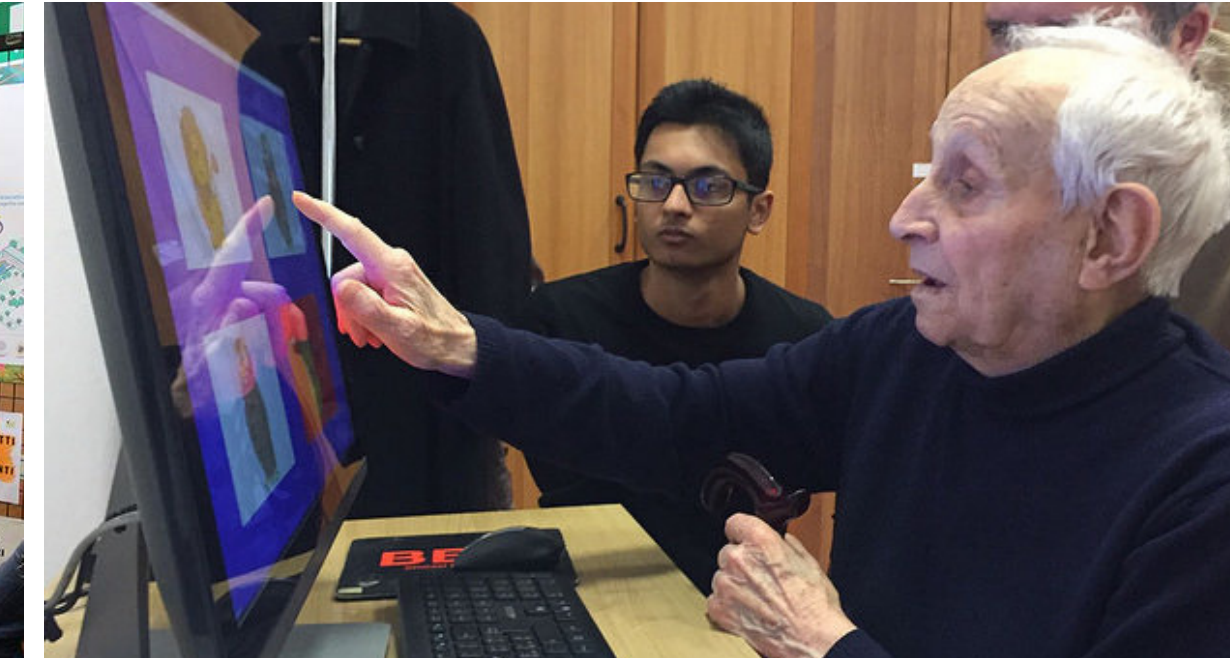

# CENTRE FOR FAMILIES

It's the landmark for families with children from 0 to 18 years old in Bologna.

An informative space made to know the opportunities in the educational, scholastic, social, normative and leisure topic. It offers personalized advice for the support to the parenthood.

It works in collaboration with the social services to promote and to sustain families' well-being through educational advices, cultural and conflicts' mediations, the development of group interventions and to activate the resources that the families themselves can stake in terms of switch and mutual help everyday.

The Centre for families is the benchmark, at the city level, for projects of family welcome and custody. At the Centre for families you can also ask for information and for the start of the investigation finalized to obtain the eligibility for the adoption by the Court.

# INTERNATIONAL PROTECTION

It is addressed to the asylum seekers, to the holders of international and humanitarian protection and to unaccompanied foreign minors; it constitutes the benchmark for the access and the taking charge of the asylum seekers, of the refugees and of the unaccompanied.

it includes activities of reception, hospitality, social support , help with the practices for the recognition of international protection and linguistic-cultural mediation aimed at facilitating the access to the services. It coordinates the SPRAR system (National service of protection of asylum seekers and refugees) at the city level, ensuring the taking in charge of all the people included: adults, families and unaccompanied foreign minors.





## HOUSING TRANSITION

Housing transition and emergency accommodation services represent a response to the emergency of families and marginalized people through the temporary provision of apartments.

Housing reception is supported by the work of a multiprofessional team, in order to build up a way towards the rehabilitation and the achievement of a greater personal and living independence. This service is addressed to the families with children or single inhabitant in houses burdened by eviction ordinances, in urgently and temporary provided spaces by social services, or spaces improperly used as a home.



## CONTRAST TO SERIOUS ADULT MARGINALISATION

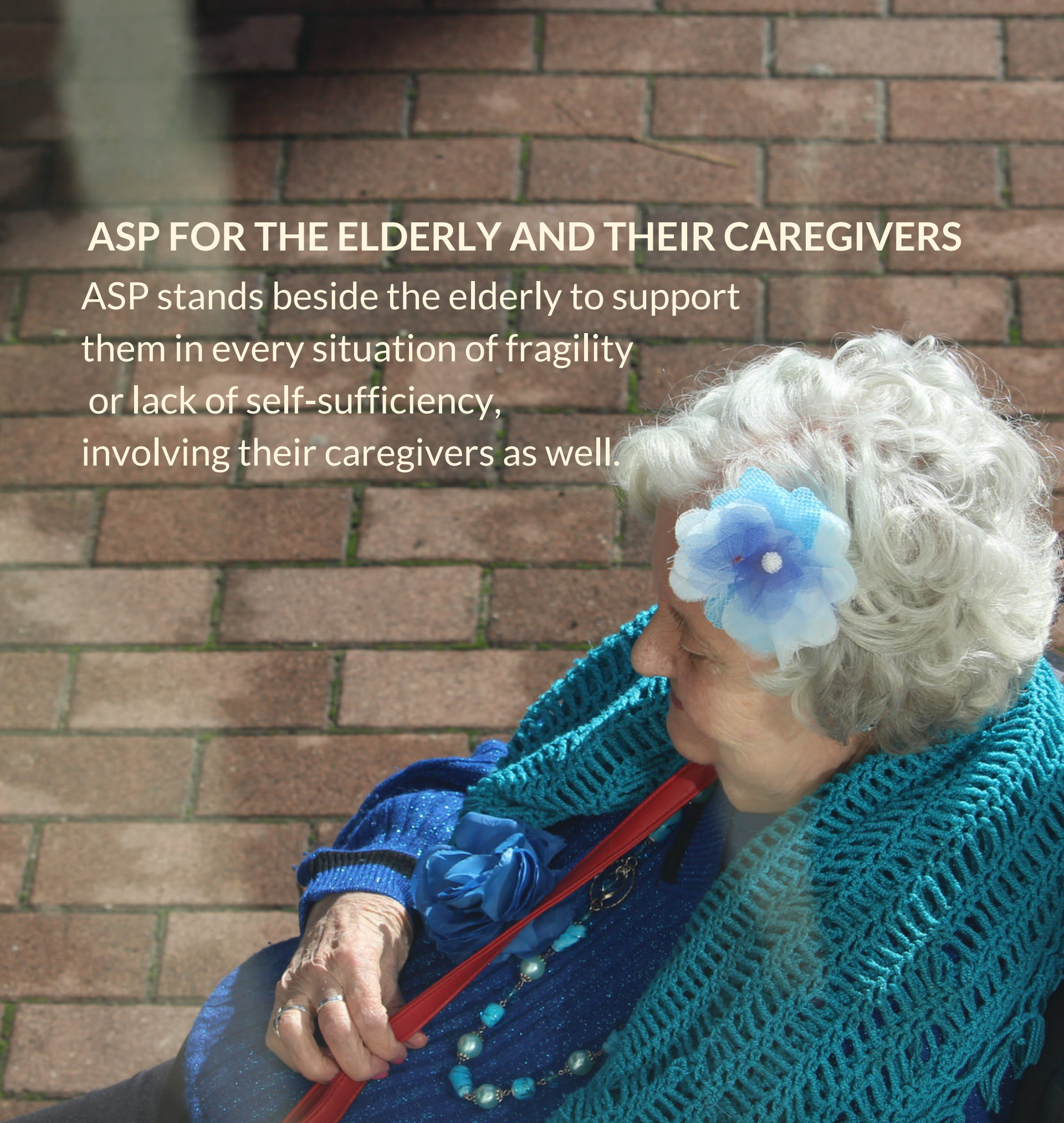
The service takes care of the homeless people in the city. The first approach is the “Housing First”, that is to say “the house before anything else” as a primary human right, based on the taking charge of the people and the support in the social and sanitary services, in a path of social integration and wellbeing.

Besides the hospitality, the local services and the different interventions for the integration, the service manages the “Cold plan” of the city of Bologna to offer hospitality during the night to homeless people, through the provision of many beds and the monitoring and support of the Street Units.

The service also offers interventions dedicated to the prisoners and to the sinti people living in authorized areas.

## ASP FOR THE ELDERLY AND THEIR CAREGIVERS

ASP stands beside the elderly to support them in every situation of fragility or lack of self-sufficiency, involving their caregivers as well.



### Residential Services

They host people with welfare needs of various intensity.

They are divided into:

- Safe apartments, a service addressed to the self-sufficient people who are 65 or older. It offers a chance of residential autonomous life in a supervised and safe place.
- Residential House for the Elderly, a non-hospital residential service that offers performances and welcomes self-sufficient elderly people.
- Retirement Home, a residential structure of assistential nature meant for completely or partially self-sufficient elderly people.

### Domiciliary services

They support the residency of the elderly people who need assistance. It is an individualized project shared with the people, the families, health services and the informal network. They also offer temporary recovery and post hospital releases, home meals, laundry, social alarm devices and teleassistance, contrast to the effects of heat waves and they support the hiring of employees (family assistants).

## ASP FOR THE ELDERLY AND THEIR CAREGIVERS

### Day care Centre

It is a semi-residential structure for social and health services that helps partially and not self-sufficient elderly people, by implementing rehabilitation programs and socialization projects. It aims to keep the elderly people in their living environment as much as possible.

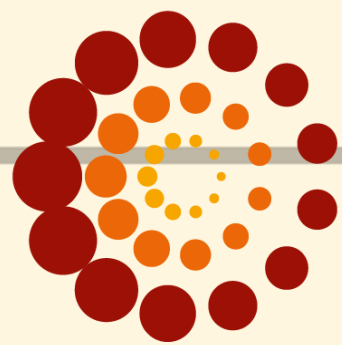
### Margherita Meeting Centre

It is an innovative service addressed to elderly people with memory or cognitive deterioration disorders and to their relatives and assistants. It provides structured activities aimed at slowing down the progression of the disease.

### Alzheimer Café

It is a meeting situation addressed to the people with memory and/or cognitive deterioration disorders. The café's aim is to be a moment of relief and sharing, a place where they can feel less alone.
